The International Childbirth Initiative's Development

Evolved out of a few programs that were designed for "mother-friendly" services, following the launch of the Baby Friendly Hospital Initiaitive.

- In the U.S.: The Coalition for Improving Maternity Services' (CIMS)
 MotherFriendly Hospital Initiative (2007)
- International: Mother-Baby Friendly Birthing Facilities created by FIGO, ICM, WRA, IPA, and WHO (2015)

ICI launched in 2018 for the Mother – Baby – Family triad

The Initiative also supports a friendly environment for the health care providers

The International Childbirth Initiative

ICI provides a framework for implementation of safe and respectful care practices and policies, the 12 Steps for Safe and Respectful MotherBaby-Family Maternity Care. It is implemented through individual health facilities, through self-evaluation, reflection, goal-setting, and community participation.

ICI provides a global resource network striving to share learning and improve the provision of care.

- ICI was created by International Federation of Gynecology and Obstetrics, the International MotherBaby Childbirth Organization, ICM, IPA, and White Ribbon Alliance
- ICI is endorsed by >30 partner organizations and growing.
- Open to all birthing facilities who are willing to commit to delivering safe and respectful MotherBaby-Family Maternity Care.

Create and submit an Action Plan

Set schedule for ongoing committee meetings

Develop a plan for collecting patient surveys (available in your Kobo account)

Collect patient surveys

Participate in ICI Collective meetings with other facilities**

Conduct regular committee meetings (following schedule set at first meeting):

- Select target steps to address first/next based on ongoing self-assessment
- Review patient surveys
- Create, update, and implement action plans

General questions about health facility:

Access to family, companions, and doulas

Number and type of staff available (midwives, ob/gyn, pediatricians, etc)
Number of annual deliveries
C/S rate
Availability of rooming-in of newborn



The application initially included a review of policies, but this is now done after admission to ICI to accelerate process and prevent delays in participation

Application available in English, Spanish, French, Japanese (online) and Arabic (paper application)

Forming a multidisciplinary committee

Each facility is asked to form a committee that will guide their work on the 12 steps

This committee should reflect the range of professionals who provide maternal and newborn care

It may include administrative staff and psychosocial service staff.

It must include at least one community representative that is not part of the paid staff

It should include junior staff and avoid hierarchy – the lead person on the committee should not necessarily be the chief of the unit.


